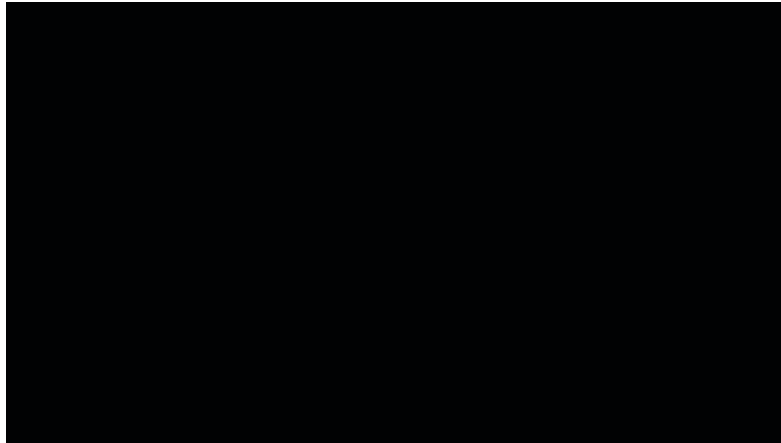

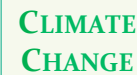

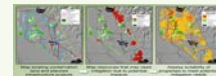

Senate Bill 391 (LIU)

REQUIRES CALTRANS TO:



- IDENTIFY THE STATEWIDE INTEGRATED MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM
- PREPARE INTERIM REPORT TO LEGISLATURE, BY DECEMBER 31, 2012, BASED ON SB 375 SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITIES STRATEGIES AND THEIR INFLUENCE STATEWIDE
- DEVELOP STATE TRANSPORTATION PLAN BY DECEMBER 31, 2015 THAT IDENTIFIES THE INTEGRATED, MULTIMODAL SYSTEM NEEDED TO ACHIEVE MAXIMUM FEASIBLE GREENHOUSE GAS REDUCTIONS

Three Major Elements

1. INTEGRATING STATEWIDE MODAL PLANS AND PROGRAMS
2. BUILDING UPON REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANS AND SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY STRATEGIES
3. DEVELOPING ROBUST MODELING TOOLS TO ANALYZE DIFFERENT SCENARIOS AND STRATEGIES

- Goods Movement Action Plan - Phase II - [January 2007](#)




Putting Plans into Action

- **Trade Corridor Improvement Fund (TCIF)**
 - Partnership based: modal operators, regional agencies, California Transportation Commission & Caltrans
 - 71 capital projects with \$7.9 billion in total funding
 - 57 completed Environmental
 - 25 completed Design
 - 17 completed Right of Way
 - 12 under construction
 - 1 complete: Columbia Ave. Grade Separation in Riverside
 - All must be under construction by December 2013



TCIF Northern California Projects

- Seaports
4 projects \$720 million
- Railroads
1 project \$79 million
- Grade Separations
1 project \$38 million
- Highways
6 projects \$606 million



Marine Highway



- Ports of Stockton, West Sacramento & Oakland
 - Multiple projects
 - Channel deepening to allow bigger ships
 - Harbor improvements
 - New dock-side equipment
 - Landside access improvements
 - TCIF, TIGER, Port and other funding



TCIF Southern California Projects

Seaports
6 projects \$1.374 billion

Railroads
6 projects \$515 million

Grade Separations
28 projects \$2.324 billion

Highways
16 projects \$2.240 billion



Colton Crossing Under Construction



- Grade separation of transcontinental tracks
- 110+ trains per day
- Partners: BNSF, UP, SanBAG, CTC, Caltrans
- \$202 million total project
- Completion: 2014
- Benefits: safety, air quality, noise, congestion reduction, operations efficiency
